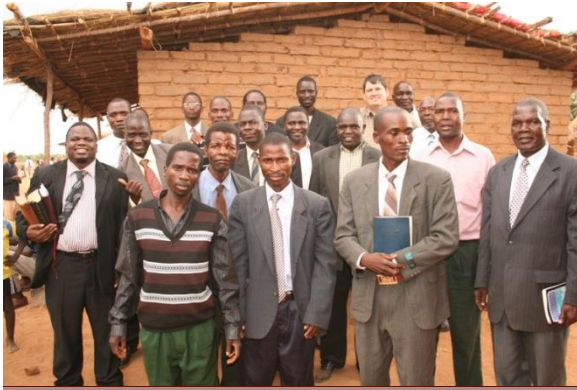

XTUPIE - Who are we?

We are an inter denominal ministry in Southern Africa that is dedicated to seeing the Gospel of Jesus Christ declared throughout Southern Africa and the world, through Evangelism. We are willing to partner with any church or ministry, who have similar goals of seeing the lost saved through Jesus Christ.

The ministry was founded by Pastors Martin and Suzette De Villiers in 2010 and to date more than 100,000 people have been saved and many more healed by the power of God, through our ministry outreaches.

We have the following ministries working together with us under our banner:

- Malawi for Jesus – An ministry to the tribal areas of Malawi
- Holy Cross Pentecostal Church International – A large church denomination mainly in Malawi, but also in other Chichewa speaking nations such as South Africa, Malawi, Zambia, Mozambique and Tanzania.

Malawi for Jesus

Malawi for Jesus was founded in Lilongwe on 2nd of September 2011 during our first our reach to Malawi. We saw the need was too great for us as individuals, so we started a partnership with the Holy Cross Pentecostal Church of Malawi, to take the message of Jesus Christ to the rural/tribal areas of Malawi through crusades, outreaches and conventions.

The founding Pastors were Pastor's Martin and Suzette De Villiers (South Africa), Dr Apostle Sam Gama, Bishop. George Mkandawire (Malawi).

Every country that we minister in is based on a partnership with local church and us.

The Local church is used because they have the knowledge of the country and an intimate knowledge of the needs of the people within the country. The Local Church also supports, advertises, supplies interpreters, ministers, ministry teams, helpers and musicians for each crusade.

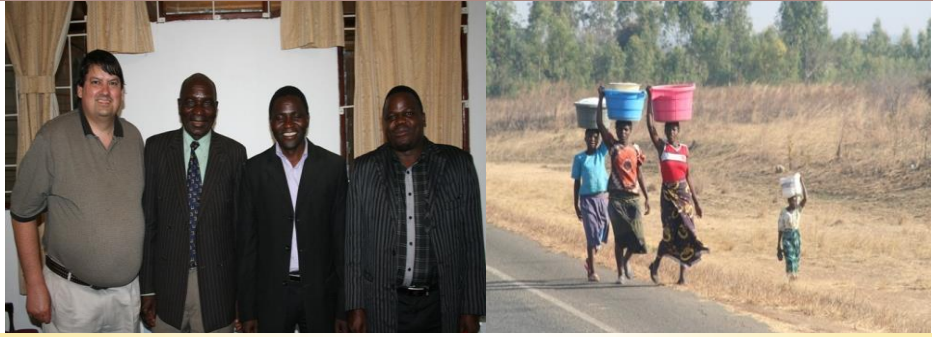
The Local church also decide where the crusade will take place and set up and gets all the necessary consent from the relevant local Authorities, chiefs and village leaders of the community for the proposed outreach as well as accommodation for all the team.

The Local church provides us with a suggested program, suggested topic which they would like me to preach / teach on and also a supply us with a budget for the outreach expenses, which is approved and the money is brought with us on the outreach!

Our Vision

- To bring the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the world through evangelism.
- To bring Salvation knowledge of Jesus Christ to the individual
- To bring the healing power of Jesus Christ to the people so that they too can be healed
- To up lift the community and common people
- To bring Hope to the hopeless
- Train up the leadership of the church.
- Assist with the building of churches and infrastructure in the rural areas
- Assist the pastors, widows and orphans

How can you help?

- We need people with a similar vision to partner with us in making this ministry in Malawi a success.
- The harvest is incredibly large and the need so great that we are willing to partner with any ministry with similar goals to come to Malawi and help.
- We cannot do it alone and we need all the help you are willing to give.
- We need prayer and the churches to get involved.

The Current Needs

- We need a 4x4 to go into the rural area – currently we use a small private car to drive into the ministry areas.
- We need finances to build infrastructure like churches, orphanages, schools and clinics
- We need finances to go to Malawi and to arrange outreaches – currently we fund all the outreaches.



These budget expenses are our air tickets, transportation during our stay in Malawi as well as our accommodation. We also pay for the hiring of sound equipment, transportation of the Pastors who are part of our ministry team, including their accommodation and some of the food for the meetings, this usually works out to about \$3,000.00. We also pay for the most important event, which is the pastor's dinner on Sunday evening!

Once we have our program and topics to preach, we (Suzette and I), pray over the outreach and what God wants us to do. At this time we ask God if this is the correct time and if He says yes, we start to prepare for that specific outreach by praying for the outreach as God leads us.

We then make a list of the prayer items which God gives us and we send it to the local church for them to join us in prayer and fasting.

During the whole lead up to the outreach we keep in constant contact with the pastors using WhatsApp, E-mail, SMS and Telephone calls. During our time of preparation we often join up with the Local church, through Skype during the prayer meetings. Also all the sermons are prepared and typed out for distribution to the Local Church as a resource for the pastors to use.

Church Building

Currently we have built twelve churches throughout Malawi, we are currently in the process building two more churches in all the areas where we have ministered.

Church building is a joint project. The church supplies the bricks and cement. They build the church to roof height and then we provide all the roofing materials.

The cost of Roofing one Church is about \$1,500 and we gather this through friends and partners who donate finances towards this ministry.

Orphanages in Malawi

In July 2014, we started to assist an orphanage in the Dowa region where we feed 250 orphans by giving them one meal a day at school. In villages there are no orphanages as the local villages allocate each orphan to a home where they grow up as a child in the family. However due to the extreme poverty we assist the orphans by supplying a meal at school and an education.

Holy Cross Pentecostal Church

The ministry with whom, we partner in Malawi, is the Holy Cross Pentecostal church. They have branches throughout South Africa, Malawi, Mozambique, Tanzania and Zambia – mainly in the Chichewa speak regions. Currently there are more than 250 churches with thousands of members throughout these regions. This ministry was founded by Dr Apostle Sam Gama in 1992.

Through this ministry, we have access to every corner of Malawi and also favour with the chiefs and tribal leaders. Many of the chiefs in the regions we minister, gives us the ground to build churches throughout Malawi.

About Malawi

As I said before Malawi is extremely poor, and the government does it best but often is not in a position to so supply most of the infrastructure they desperately need.

The rural areas are remote, and people exist on farming. Infrastructure is very limited, and people need to walk more than 50 kilometres to get medical help at a clinic.

The national road system is fair, but this changes drastically once you travel to the villages, where we usually travel about 20 kilometre's in about an hour due to road conditions. There is also limited public transport on the main route network and most people use busses and taxi. Due to the extreme poverty many people will either walk or ride bicycles to where they need to be.

What I can promise you is that Malawi is friendly, safe and open to the Gospel of Jesus Christ and through Holy Cross Pentecostal Churches and Malawi for Jesus, anyone who want can access to these people.

Malawi is open to anyone who will come. It is rough but well worth the time, money and effort you invest in it. The people of this country need people and ministries like yours, to help in their time of need. Please will you help by either coming to Malawi and doing outreaches or by sponsoring those who are already established in Malawi and who are currently doing outreaches in the country?
