



What to do when things go wrong in your life

Introduction

We all are believing and sometimes through teaching that God is good and He is for us not against and so many other scriptures and all of them are true. God Loves you and I with an everlasting love, His is most surely for us and not actively against us or punishing us in any way but why do we not see these things working in our life?

In the next two messages I will explain why we do not always have a level life without any trouble, trails, and tribulation.

The first session I want to explain what God did for us at calvary and in my second session I will explain why bad things can and do happen to faithful Christians. Basically, What to do when thing do not go according to our plan, what do we do when things go wrong, even though we are doing the right Godly things!

We do all the right things, we server God, we go to church, we read our Bibles and pray but we do not see that the promises fulfilled in our lives.

Instead, we see the opposite of what we read in the Bible which are not evident in our life because things are going wrong and not as planned or what we read in the Bible.

What do we do? What is wrong? Are we not serving God properly or is there unconfessed sin and therefore we are being punished but God for our sin?

The answer is simple no, God is not mad or cross with you, and No God is not punishing you for your sins and most importantly God is not punishing you for anything you did or did not do.

Do not allow Satan to steal from you, particularly Satan wants to steal you joy because your joy is what is keeping you in God.

God poured our His anger on Jesus Christ.

The first thing we need to understand is God is not punishing us for any sin or lack of doing something, God is not like that and His rath was pour out on Jesus Christ at the Cross of Calvary.

The problem is we are quick to judge people by our own standard which are mostly incorrect and secondly we have no idea who God is and what happened at the Cross of Calvary.

And thirdly we are all guilty, remember when you point a finger at someone else you are point three at yourself.

So, let me explain as best as I can to show you that God loves you so much more than you ever thought or can understand.

Let my categorically say that God is not punishing you for your sin or lack of doing anything, how can I be so confident?

My Bible says that God pour out all His Wrath our sin deserves on Jesus Christ and gave us this TOTAL Forgiveness of our sin as a gift called Eternal Life.



John 3:16-18 *"¹⁶ For God so loved the world that He (God) gave His One and Only Son (Jesus Christ), that whoever believes in Him (Jesus Christ for their forgiveness of sin) shall not perish (Die in sin and go to hell) but have eternal life. ¹⁷ For God did not send his Son (Jesus) into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him. (Jesus Christ) ¹⁸ Whoever believes in Him (Jesus Christ) is not condemned (going to Heaven), but whoever does not believe stands condemned already (going to Hell), because they have not believed in the Name of God's One and only Son. (Jesus Christ)"*

God in His infinite wisdom chose to send Jesus Christ, His Only Son, to earth to become the perfect Sacrifice for our sin, the sin of the entire Human race.

Jesus Christ paid the FULL PRICE for the Sin of the entire Human Race at the Cross of Calvary, once and for all time.

God took all your sin and all my sin and all the sin of every person who has ever lived or who will ever live on this earth from Adam and Eve until the last person to be born on earth and place all that SIN on Jesus Christ at the Cross of Calvary and pour out all His Wrath for our SIN on Jesus Christ and Jesus Christ paid the FULL PRICE that our Sin deserved so that we never have to. What was the price of sin? **Death**

Jesus Christ had to die and paid the full price that our Sin requires. **1 Corinthians 15:56**, says *"⁵⁶ The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law."*

So, the Law gave sin its power, and power of sin caused us to die spiritually and physically, this is called the sting of death which is SIN. There is NO WAY any of us can pay for our own SIN so without Jesus Christ who die for your and my sin and the Sin of entire human race by His Death we are/will be condemned to paid for our sin in a place separate for the presence of God called Hell to pay for all eternity for our sin.

Romans 6:23 says *"²³ For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."* The Bible says that the payment for a life of sin is death, or separation from God, so if you die in your sin, you will be separated from God in a place we call Hell.

But verse 23 also says the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus, **1 Corinthians 15:57**, says it like this *"⁵⁷ But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ."*

We have victory over our sin, ONLY through accepting the Gift of God, Jesus Christ.

No Condemnation for sin anymore

And because you are now set Free from your sin, there is now NO CONDEMNATION.

God does not condemn you at all because through receiving Jesus Christ as your Saviour your sins are paid for and have been removed.

That is why **Romans 8:1-5** says *"¹ Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, ² because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you free from the law of sin and death. ³ For what the law was powerless to do because it was weakened by the flesh, God did by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh to be a sin*



offering. And so, he condemned sin in the flesh, ⁴ in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.”

So, never let Satan, no demon from hell or any person tell you God is punishing you for your sin, your sin was delt for and paid for at the Cross of Calvary but Jesus Christ Himself and God will never punish you or condemn you again because Jesus Christ paid for your sin in FULL.
