Introduction

Each and everyone here today has a price on your head?

Whether you believe it or not there is a price on your head right now and that price is too much for any of us to pay.

You see that Bible tell us in **Romans 3:23** that "for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God"

So we are all sinners. When Adam and Eve sinned their sin was passed from generation to generation and we are all sinners and there really is NO HOPE, because the price on our head, the price we cannot pay, the price for our sins is DEATH!

In Romans 6:23, the Bible says "For the wages of sin is death", the only way for us now to pay for our sins is death.

Only way to be saved!

The only way to be saved it to have someone pay the price for your sins in place of you! But who would do a thing like that?

Maybe your friend, husband or wife. Maybe your child or family member, would be willing to die in your place, the problem with this is that they too are sinners so their sin would make their sacrifice useless!

So the only way to be saved is to have someone who is perfect and sinless to die in your place! Is there anyone sinless and prepared to die for my sins here in Chitkula, in Malawi, in Africa, in the whole world?

The answer there is only one person who can and had already died in your place for your sins. And **His Name is Jesus Christ**.
