

What Jesus Christ did for you – Saved us from Judgement

Introduction

For the last four weeks, we have been in a series titled “God is not mad with you?”

Firstly, we discussed the Corrugated Christian life where we talked about Jesus Christ came to this earth so that we could a life above our normal circumstances and so that we could live the supernatural life that He paid for us to live, that is to live a life that is above the natural way people live.

Then we discussed the Image many people have of God that is often blurred by our past experiences and last week we discussed Jesus Christs Atoning sacrifice that covered you and my sin!

Last week we spoke about reconciliation and righteousness, Jesus Christ’s death on the Cross of Calvary reconciled mankind to God because sin was totally dealt with, **2 Corinthians 5:18** says that we are reconciled to God through Jesus Christ and now we are declared righteous or in other words, we have the right to be in the very presence of God because our sin was totally blotted out through the Atoning sacrifice of Jesus Christ.

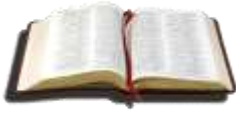
Jesus Christ is the only way to God

Jesus Christ is the only way to God, and this IS the reason why if you want to come to God, you MUST come the only WAY God created according to **John 14:6**, which is Jesus Christ.

There is no other way, there is no other god, no matter the name of the god is, there are no works or things we can do, **Isaiah 64:6**, which says **“And all our righteousness’s are like filthy rags;”**.

That means no matter what we try and do to reconcile with God they are as filthy rags or cloths before God because they can never compare to the great sacrifice, pain, and scorning that God placed on Jesus Christ at the Cross of Calvary so that Jesus Christ and only Jesus Christ could bring atonement totally remove sin for mankind, redemption to redeem all mankind with the cost of His Life, and therefore Jesus Christ brought reconciliation between man and God.

I want you to understand there is no other way to God, to go to Heaven but through the precious Blood of Jesus Christ which was shed for the sin of all of mankind who accept this Sacrifice!



If you do not accept Jesus Christ as your Saviour then your sins are not blotted out and you have to deal with your sin before an Almighty God who cannot tolerate sin, any sin!

Therefore, if you do not accept Jesus Christ's sacrifice for yourself, you will forever be separated from God and Heaven in a place of punishment and horrors, a place prepared for the devil and his angels, it was never created to punish mankind, but you will go there and will be punished for all eternity.

The writer of Hebrews says in **Hebrews 2:1-4** *“Therefore we must give the more earnest heed to the things we have heard, lest we drift away. ² For if the word spoken through angels proved steadfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just reward, ³ how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation, which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard Him, ⁴ God also bearing witness both with signs and wonders, with various miracles, and gifts of the Holy Spirit, according to His own will?”*

What Jesus paid for - Judgement

I want to just praise God that He sent Jesus Christ to save us from our sin, He saved us from the Judgements to come and especially this terrible fate in a place called Death and Hades or Hell, and gave us eternal life instead of eternal separation from God.

Today, I want to explain what Jesus Christ is saving us from, and why His death blotted your sin away forever and made us Spiritually alive in Him. When you accepted Him as your personal Saviour you moved from death into life.

Never to receive Judgement because your sin was totally blotted out, paid for by Jesus Christ.

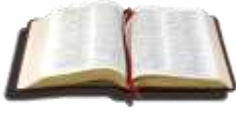
Judgment unto Life

So, what will happen if you have not accepted Jesus Christ as your Saviour, what will happen when you die?

The moment you die you will appear before God to be judged to determine if you accepted Jesus Christ as your Saviour or not. This judgment will determine where you will spend eternity, whether in Heaven or in Hell.

The Bible clearly tell us what will happen when we die, **Hebrews 9:27** *“²⁷ And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment.”*

When we die, we will all face judgment, at this judgment, a book called “The Lamb's Book of Life”, is opened and a search is made to see if your name is written in this book. Your name is recorded in “The Lamb's Book of Life”, the moment you accepted Jesus Christ as your Saviour!



So, a search is made, and if your name is found in “The Lamb’s Book of Life” because when you accepted Jesus Christ’s payment for your sin, you will enter Heaven.

However, if your name is not found in “The Lamb’s Book of Life”, you will be sent to Hell because even though Jesus Christ died for your sin, you never accepted His sacrifice and therefore you cannot lay any claim to any benefit He purchased on your behalf at the Cross of Calvary and because of your sin, you cannot enter Heaven because you will be destroyed.

So you will be sent to Hell, a place of suffering and pain to wait for your judgment at another judgment called “The Great White Throne”, where you will be given a fair trial and judgment based on all the sins you committed in your life.

Sadly every one of us is guilty because only the Blood of Jesus Christ can wash away our sin, and because we are guilty, we are sentenced to eternal separation from God in a place called the Lake of Fire this the Bible says is called the Second Death.

Jesus Christ spoke more about Hell than any other topic during His earthly ministry because it was so important for people to understand that every one of us was heading there because none of us are righteous or good enough to go to Heaven on our own because of our sin separates us from God – **Isaiah 59:2**.

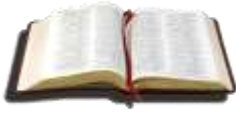
That is why Jesus Christ came to this earth, to live the perfect life and to fulfil every requirement of the Law for sin and thereby taking away the power of sin which is the Law, and He also took away the sting of death (the eternal separation from God), which was sin, according to **1 Corinthians 15:56** *“⁵⁶ The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law.”*, and because the power of sin is dealt with, death, Hell and the grave were defeated!

Jesus Christ took all the SIN of all mankind on Himself at the Cross of Calvary and become mankind’s Atoning sacrifice by blotting out all sin, defeating Death, Hell, and the Grave, and redeeming mankind from the effect of sin which is death or eternal separation from God presence.

You and I have been bought with a price, the precious Blood of Jesus Christ and to accept Him and His sacrifice for yourself means eternal life with him in Heaven because He has paid for your sin, but to reject Him or not accept Him or to ignore Him is all as good as rejecting Him and therefore you sin is not covered, and you will die!

Death always means separation! When a loved one dies you cannot communicate with them anymore. You cannot phone them, e-mail them or talk to them or see them because they are gone, they have been separated from their loved ones in death.

In the same way that death separates you from your loved ones when you die without accepting Jesus Christ, you die or are separated from the presence of God,



and at the second death, when you are judged at the Great White Throne and thrown into the Lake of Fire, you are separated for God totally.

I do not know about you, but I want to go to heaven, nobody wants to go to Hell, we all want to go to Heaven but unless we accept Jesus Christ as our Saviour, unless we receive His atoning sacrifice to blot out our sin for eternity, we will not be able to stand before an All-Mighty God.

The Great White Thorne Judgement

After the judgment on whether you accepted Jesus Christ or not, you will at the end of time give an account for your sin before God at "The Great White Throne" judgment.

Let me read what Jesus said about this judgment in **Matthew 25:31-46**, I want to remind you if you are born again, you are not part of this judgment also]spoken of in **Revelation 20:12-13**.

This judgment is at the end of the age, after the Millennial reign of Christ. These are those who died without Jesus Christ as their Saviour, the Spiritually dead.

They come and stand before "The Great White Throne", their bodies are summoned from their graves and the sea, and their souls are called from death and hades to stand before the Judge of all the earth.

I will just read **Matthew 25:41 & 45-48** which is an account of the trial ⁴¹ *"Then He will also say to those on the left hand, 'Depart from Me, you cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels. 45 Then He will answer them, saying, 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to Me.' 46 And these will go away into everlasting punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."*

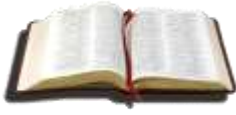
Revelation 20:12-15 gives us a further account of this trial, ¹¹ *"And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.*

¹² *And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.*

¹³ *And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.*

¹⁴ *And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.*

¹⁵ *And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire."*



Closing

Jesus Christ's death and resurrection saved you from this fate and these judgments, this is why Christians call their conversion, being **SAVED** because they were saved from these judgments and the eternal effect of their sin through the Death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

This is what Jesus Christ did for mankind, every person who was, who is, and whoever will be born, Jesus Christ has already paid a full price for their sin by dying on the Cross of Calvary for their **SIN!** All we have to do is receive and accept Jesus Christ, accept His sacrifice for our sin.

This means nothing unless you personally submit your life to Jesus Christ and accept Jesus Christ's death on the Cross of Calvary as full payment for your sin and receive Him as your Saviour and you become His Child.

Good people do not go to Heaven, Saved people go to heaven!

The time is short, none of us know if tonight the last time might be, we hear the Gospel of Jesus Christ, so, I want to invite anyone who wants to accept Jesus Christ as their Saviour to pray this prayer after me:

Prayer

Lord Jesus

I thank you for dying for my sin on the Cross of Calvary

I recognize that I am a sinner and I need a Saviour

I repent of my sin, and I ask Jesus Christ to come into my life and be my Lord and Saviour!

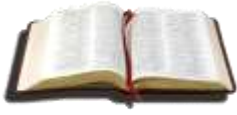
I believe that you are the Son of God and I declare that Jesus Christ is Lord
And I believe that God rose Jesus Christ from the dead and He is alive in Heaven.

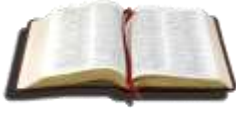
Thank you that I am your child, God,

RIGHTEOUSNESS

Next, we need to understand, that while we were still caught up in our sin, even before any of us were born, in fact before the foundation of the universe, God demonstrated His love to us that Jesus Christ already died for us, in our place.

He died so that you can live! He took sin out of the picture because sin was causing our separation from God.

This is what **Romans 5:8-10**, it says “But God demonstrates his own love for us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, because we have now been declared righteous by his blood, we will be saved through him from God's wrath. For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of his Son, how much more, since we have been reconciled, will we be saved by his life?”.

Before we even knew who God was, before we were even born or born again, actually before the foundation of this world, God's love was for us, it was for you! God loves YOU!

Jesus Christ died on the Cross of Calvary to make you RIGHTEOUS, or in right standing with God!

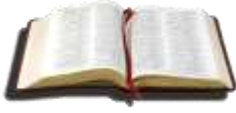
From the day you accept Jesus Christ as your personal Saviour, Jesus Christ's death on the Cross of Calvary makes you in right standing with God! You have the right to stand in the very presence of God!

This is VERY GOOD NEWS, however, each person, each one of us must accept or reject this finished work of Jesus Christ on the Cross of Calvary for ourselves to obtain the full pardon of our sin.

Jesus Christ paid a debt none of us could pay by paying the FULL PRICE for SIN, Sin was a debt that none of us could pay for ourselves but if we reject this Salvation in Jesus Christ alone there is no forgiveness of sin, and the Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ will have no effect on our lives, and we will die in our sin without a means for Salvation.

Remember, when Adam sinned, it did not surprise God or catch Him off guard! He had already made a plan; the plan was that Jesus Christ's blood would redeem us from our SINS so that we can be made Righteous and Justified.

Just a side note, whenever you see the word **justified**, think just as if I have never sinned! So Jesus' death on the cross meant that God see me, you, everyone in the world JUSTIFIED, just as they have never sinned.



And then most important, now that your sins are forgiven, taken away and you have been declared righteous, you have become reconciled to God

RIGHTEOUS

Another word we often see in the scriptures is the word **RIGHTEOUS** or **RIGHTEOUSNESS**. This is a very similar concept to Justification, but this word means that you have the right to stand in God presence because of what Jesus Christ did for you on the Cross of Calvary.

So, Jesus Death made us in right standing before God just as if we have NEVER sinned. That should make you very excited.

Jesus Christs Death on the cross made us Righteous, in right standing before God, Justified, just as if we have NEVER sinned”

David put it in **Psalm 130:3-4**, like this “If you, O LORD, were to keep track of sins, O Lord, who could stand before you, But you are willing to forgive so that you might be honoured.”.

Without the sacrifice of Jesus, how would we possibly be justified or be righteous before a completely just God?

If God kept records of our sins, how would we ever stand in His presence? You see God is so Holy that even the slightest blemish of sin would discount us.

That is why He had to send Jesus a perfect sacrifice, one who was totally Holy, totally Righteous and Totally pure and without sin to die on our behalf of all mankind, a sacrifice that was once and for all eternity and for everybody who would accept His Son sacrifice for themselves as their Saviour.

Jesus Christ justified us, just as if we have never sinned, opening our right standing with God (Righteousness) so that we have access to the very presence of God by His Grace and Mercy and through our FAITH in Him.

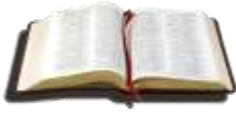
That is why. **“WITHOUT FAITH is impossible to please God”**, **Hebrews 11:6**, because without Faith we cannot experience God, we have to believe that He is who He says He is, He has done what he said He has done, He will do what He says He will do and that He has made a place for us through His Son, there is no other way to approach Him but by Faith in Him.

It is all through His Word and no other way!

And that is why our own righteousness or works whatever we use to try and get access to God is according to **Isaiah 64:6**, is as **“filthy rages”**, the Hebrew word is “aid” Strong’s reference 5708 (means menstrual rag), something detestable.

Why because we cannot obtain righteousness, right stand with God by ourselves, by our works, by anything else but Jesus Christ. When we try to do this, we ignore the Righteousness / the right standing that comes through faith in Christ!

So we need to do it God’s way! We obtain GRACE through Faith in Christ finished work on the cross, as it says in Ephesians 2:8-9, **“For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.”**



It is only by God's grace and mercy and our applied faith in these facts that we have access so no one can boast in anything, any works, any special abilities but the Christ sacrifice and God's mercy and grace.

We need to do what God's word, we need to put His word in action in our lives and becoming doers of His word and not merely getting head knowledge, even if this contradicts what we were taught or what we believe we need to choose God's word over our ideas, thoughts, training etc.

As **James 1:22-26**, says "But become doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. Because if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, this one is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; for he observed himself and has gone away, and immediately forgot what sort of man he was. But the one who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one shall be blessed in what he does."

I do not know if you are aware but when a silversmith refines silver, he will continue to heat it and remove the dross until he can see his own reflection in the silver, so it must be as we look into perfect mirror of God's word, we must continually remove the dross in our lives. Wrong thoughts, wrong actions, wrong understanding and wrong beliefs about we and mainly about God and replace them with what the Word of God says.

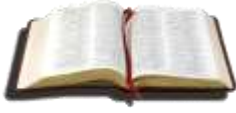
So I encourage you to take a fresh look in the mirror of His word, please take note of the scriptures and after we finish today go and spend time letting the reality of God's perfect plan of Salvation and His reassuring Word wash over you so that you can start experiencing His GRACE and MERCY.

When we become doers of the word of God, we might find that some concepts are difficult to understand or apply, then we need to go before God and do what His word says, Proverbs 1:7 says, "*that the fear of God is the beginning of all wisdom*".

We who lack wisdom should ask God for it, as it says in **James 1:5-8**, "*If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all generously and without reproach, and it shall be given to him. But let him ask in faith, doubting nothing, for he that doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. For let not that man suppose that he shall receive anything from the Lord; he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.*"

Let me just pause and explain the double minded man, I am sure it will be explained in one of the sessions, but briefly,

1 Corinthians 2:16 says that "*We have the mind of Christ*" but we also have in our flesh realm (Soul and body) and mind, thoughts, reasoning. This is the area that Satan has access to, and is normally controlled by our fleshly desires, the world or



even Satan. This is battlefield and God has given us specific weapons to fight in this realm in Ephesians 6:11.

The belt of truth in the KJV it says the loins guarded by truth

The breastplate of Righteousness – Right Standing with God

The shoe of preaching the Gospel – The good news Jesus Christ has paid the debt for our sins and God is not mad at us.

The shield of Faith – We need to put our faith in His GRACE and MERCY so that we can put out the fiery darts / arrows of the Satan.

The helmet of Salvation – The knowledge that Jesus Christ did it all, I am justified, just as if I never sinned, Right standing before God, protecting our mind so that we can have the Mind of Christ.

The Sword of the Word of God – God's word is our defence mechanism.

We have only been given one offensive weapon, why because Christ did EVERYTHING else for us at the cross of Calvary, it has been done ALREADY!!!

It is only through the mirror of God's word that we have all the other pieces of armour effective in our lives:

God's word brings us truth, the truth of the Gospel, the truth of who we are in Christ. Christ death on the cross made us righteous, He brought us into right standing with God

Helmet of Salvation – Christ died so that we might have an eternal salvation

Shoes of preaching the Gospel – When you realise what Christ did for you, you will automatically start preaching.

Shield of Faith – Our faith in Christ finished work on the cross has brought us Grace and Mercy

The double minded state is when our brain says one thing and our Spirit man, the mind of Christ, says something else often in contradiction.

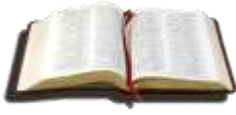
This causes us to become double minded, "Yes let's do this, not but this"

We need to become single minded; we HAVE the mind of Christ, and we need to live out of this realm, our whole being must be brought into submission to the Mind of Christ, God what do you say about this and this situation, not how do I feel about this situation.

You see it is our faith in Christ finished work on Calvary and God's grace and mercy that will bring us the breakthrough.

SIN is dealt with - Christ Died for all SIN

In understanding that, God is not mad at us and does not keep our sins against us, we must first understand and know beyond a shadow of a doubt that SIN has been totally dealt with at the cross of Calvary. It has been completely removed from the picture, and this is totally and only through



Christ's death on the cross.

Jesus Christ has dealt SIN a death blow at the cross when He said it was Finished, it was really finished and dealt with nothing more had to be done. He has justified us, **Romans 5:8-10**, just as if we have never sinned.

We know from **1 Corinthian 15:22**, "For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead also came through a man. For just as in Adam all die, so also in Christ all will be made alive".

He did this once for all time, so that we can obtain an ETERNAL redemption from sin, see **Hebrews 9:11-12**, "*But now Christ has come as the high priest of the good things to come. He passed through the greater and more perfect tent not made with hands, that is, not of this creation, and he entered once for all into the most holy place not by the blood of goats and calves but by his own blood, and so he himself secured eternal redemption*".

2 Corinthians 5:21 says "For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him".

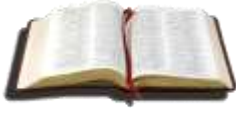
God made Jesus become sin, He place the sins of the WHOLE WORLD on Jesus, He took out all His Anger, wrath and extracted all the punishment we deserve for our sin, He took it all out and more on Jesus Christ, that is why the crucifixion was not a pretty sight and why it was so gory and filled with blood. Jesus was beaten to a pulp, whipped, spat on, swore at, and then after all that He was hung on a cross, where He bled and died for your, and mine sins and the sins of the WHOLE WORLD, no one was exempt, He died for everyone!!!

And so the sin problem WAS and IS dealt with for all Eternity. God completely judged Jesus Christ for the sins of the whole world. All of God's anger over our sins was justly punished to the full letter of the law and measure the Law required and God chose to accept Jesus Christ's complete sacrifice for all our sins at Calvary and chose to deal with us in GRACE, God riches at Christ's expense. God looks at us through the mediator Jesus Christ

1 Timothy 2:5-6 "For there is one God and one intermediary between Gods and humanity, Christ Jesus, himself human, who gave himself as a ransom for all, revealing God's purpose at his appointed time".

It is Jesus Christ who has saved us and made God not angry with us anymore.

2 Timothy 1:9-10 "He is the one who saved us and called us with a holy calling, not based on our works but on his own purpose and grace, granted to us in Christ Jesus before time began, but now made visible through the appearing of our Saviour Christ Jesus. He has broken the power of death



and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel!"

He, Jesus Christ saved us, and Grace was granted to us, and He broke the power of death and brought us immortality. So with the sin problem solved, we all have a choice to accept Jesus Christ's complete work or reject Him.

Contrary to popular belief, people do not go to Hell because of their sins, I just explain that Christ took away the ALL judgment and punishment for sin from EVERYBODY, people go to Hell because they refused to Accept Christ's finished work on the cross by refusing to Believe.

The way we are saved is found in, **Roman 10:9** says "*That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved*".

So because of Christ FINISHED work on the Cross of Calvary, where He received: The complete and just judgment for the sins of the whole world
He was judged and found guilty of all our sins.
He was sentence to the penalty our sins deserve.
He was punished and died for each and every one of our sins.
Then He went to the Father and presented His blood as our atonement.
God accepted Jesus' sacrifice for the sins of the entire world.
God chooses to not be mad at us because our sins have been dealt with.
God gives us Grace and Mercy which we must apply through Faith

We have been made Righteous, in right standing with God. We have been JUSTIFIED, just if I have never sinned and we have been given access to the throne room of God by Jesus' blood.

One last time. God it not made at you. Say "God is not mad at me; he has chosen to deal with me differently to what my sins deserve because of Jesus Christ's sacrifice.

LICENSE TO SIN

This is not a license to SIN! Remember that our sins have consequences; you will reap what you sow! God will forgive you, but sin has consequences, if you slept with a woman and she falls pregnant the consequences are the baby, if you murder or some crime the consequences of the countries punishment for the crime are your consequences. Sin has consequences.

Satan will use your sins to put a yoke on you and destroy your ministry, your marriage, and your relationships and eventually kill you

1 Peter 5:8 says that we must "Be sober,(3525 - nay-of be sober, abstain from wine, watch, be discreet) be vigilant because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion,(3023 - Leh-ohn – literal lion) walketh about, seeking whom he may devour: (2666 -Kat-ap-ee-no – To drink down, gulp entirely, devour, drown, swallow up)



Let quickly look at a lion, a lion only hunts three types of prey
The young – the young Christians but letting them believe that the Christian walk is too difficult for them to accomplish.
The Sick and the old - When you are sick because of your sins burden.
The straggles and those left alone and separate from the group - When you move out of God covering.

CLOSE

There was once a man who lived in England, he had a beautiful home, and many beautiful artifacts and priceless paintings. In fact he had one of the best private art collections ever collected.

This man lost his wife when their son was born and so he only had one son who would inherit all this treasure. But the War broke out and his son went to fight in defence of his country.

During his training he met a young artist, and they became very close friends. Unfortunately the son was killed in a major battle, but this friend survived and so after the war he decided to paint a portrait of his best friend. It took him some time but eventually it was finished.

He then packed the painting in the car and took it to his friend's father as a gift to remind him of his son.

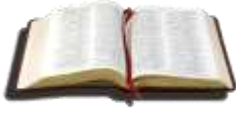
The father was very impressed that his son's best friend had done such an incredible job, he looked at the painting and recognized the resemblance to his son, but he also noticed that it really was not done perfectly but because it was a picture of his son and was done in an incredible act of love he decided that he would pay the young man, but this friend would not take a cent and left.

The old man displayed this painting in the best place in his art collection and when friends came to visit, they commented on all the flaws the painting had. Some even scoffed that he had such a painting in his collection.

One day the old man died, and his will had stipulated that his art collection be auctioned off first. The entire art world was in complete uproar because he really had a priceless collection of art.

Eventually the day of the auction dawned, many art collectors and museums from around the world came to bid on his collection. The first piece of art to be auctioned off according to the will was the painting of the man's son.

Everyone did not want it because it had too many flaws and was not worth buying according to their esteemed knowledge, so no one bid on this picture.



The auctioneer asked if anyone would please bid on the painting, but everyone shouted that he should go on to the real art and donate this piece to charity.

Just then the gardener came forward and asked if he could buy the picture of the son out of respect to the man he worked for? He only has five pounds but if they would let him, he would buy it.

The auctioneer asked if they were any other bid, going once, going twice, going three times and slammed his hammer down and said sold to the gardener.

He then announced that the action was over, people complained and asked why, none of the artwork was auction yet. The auctioneer said the old man's will said, whoever buy the picture of my son, also inherits my entire estate!

You see whoever has the son, Jesus Christ, whoever buys the fact that God is not mad at them and chooses through faith in Christ finished work on the cross also has the inheritance.

Christ did it all; there is nothing else for us to do. God met all the judgment, punishment that the law required for our sins to satisfy His anger of our sins so we can come boldly to Him,

Now we can do what Hebrew [4:16](#) says "Therefore let us come boldly to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need".
